SOUTHEAST FLORIDA'S REGIONAL VISION AND BLUEPRINT FOR ECONOMIC

PROSPERITY (SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE UPDATE)

The Southeast Florida Regional Partnership, a collaboration of the South Florida and Treasure Coast Regional Planning Councils and more than 200 regional partners, is proceeding with organizational and program activities.

Milestones and Key Accomplishments:

A) A Strong Identity

Staff is proud to announce the choice of an official name for the Southeast Florida regional vision and blueprint for economic prosperity.

The name, "Seven50," was developed in conjunction with our marketing-communications consultants in order to support the successful launch and branding of the projects. Our consultants are the brains behind naming Sirius satellite radio and Cingular, among others, and the search for the name has been an outstanding process.

The key attributes of this new name include:

- Seven50 is a strong, memorable and distinctive name that emphasizes both the "who" (the united group of seven SE Florida counties) as well as the "what" (the bold 50-year vision for the Region)
- Seven50 is a one-of-a-kind idea that is immediately recognizable by virtue of its word + number composition.
- The name stands out from every other similar type of organization not just in Florida but across the U.S.
- The name has strong "talk value." It is easy to say, remember and talk about with others.
- It is easy to translate into every language spoken in the Region

Seven50 marks a bold beginning for the project.
