 SUBJECT: SEVEN50: SOUTHEAST FLORIDA PROSPERITY PLAN

The Southeast Florida Regional Partnership, in association with the South Florida and Treasure Coast Regional Planning Councils and more than 200 regional partners, is proceeding with the creation of Seven50, Southeast Florida's Prosperity Plan.

The Partnership is developing Seven50, a seven-county, 50-year Southeast Florida Prosperity Plan that will reflect a regional agreement around priority investments in key areas of importance to Southeast Florida's future. When considered together, these issues will coalesce into a coherent strategy and investment plan in support of the future sustainability and economic prosperity of our communities and region.

The Council is working to develop Seven50 by the contract completion date of February 21, 2014. The following is a schedule of upcoming meetings and a description of each event, which includes:

**B) The Executive Committee:**

The last Executive Committee meeting was held on Friday, May 3rd, 2013, at the offices of the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). The meeting addressed: an update on results of the first Work Group meeting to develop Alternate Scenarios; a preliminary list of implementation projects; a discussion of the Third Summit; and financial and Partnership updates. The next Executive Committee meeting will be held on Friday, July 12, 2013, at the offices of the Broward MPO.

- C) **Seven50 Virtual Workgroup Meeting:**  
 On Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, The Southeast Florida Regional Partnership held a virtual discussion on the draft data and draft alternative scenarios resulting from the April 10<sup>th</sup> workgroup meetings as well as meetings with other groups and organizations. The information is draft, work in progress. It is evolving and continues to be modified as we continue to engage different stakeholders. The next Executive Committee workshop to review and comment on edits to draft Alternate Scenarios will be on Friday, June 7, 2013. Edits/comments resulting from this workshop will be incorporated into the Scenarios in an appropriate format to address during the Third Summit.
  
- D) **The Regional Opportunity Workshop:**  
 On Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, the Partnership held a Regional Opportunity Workshop with a presentation from James Carras, Carras Community Investment, Inc., on Fair Housing and Equity Assessment/Regional Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing. The workshop also had breakout groups that discussed and established a regional opportunity vision statement and identified regional opportunity goals and strategies.
  
- E) **Seven50 Outreach Update:**  
 On Monday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, a Planning Director's Forum (Indian River, Martin and St. Lucie) occurred in the northern three counties of the region. In addition, on Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, a Seven50 update was presented to school board members and superintendents of the four (4) northern counties of the Seven50 Region. Similar forums and engagement opportunities are being scheduled for the other counties in the Seven50 Region.
  
- F) **Seven50 Information Release: Draft Data and Draft Scenarios**
