FY 2011-12 DRAFT OPERATING BUDGET

#### **Background**

Staff has prepared a draft Fiscal Year 2011-12 operating budget for your review. The proposed budget, along with a Work Program for 2011-12, will be presented to the Council at the September meeting. The budget is presented in "funds" format, consistent with the Council's accounting software – the Special Revenue Funds have been subdivided into Federal, State and Local categories.

#### Revenues

The draft budget for Fiscal Year 2011-12 is \$3,672,700, an increase of 16.5% when compared to the amended budget for the current year. The difference results primarily from a substantial increase in pass-through funds associated with the Sustainable Communities Initiative. Total pass-through funds are projected to be \$1,191,000 (32.4% of the total), up from \$758,000 in the current year. Other notable changes in revenues reflect the loss of State funding through the Florida Department of Community Affairs, the absence at this time of defined funding for training and exercises through the Regional Domestic Security Task Force, and the continued reduction in revenues from the review of Developments of Regional Impact. Continuing revenues will come from administration of the Council's revolving loan funds and the multi-year contract with the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority, among others. A category has been included for new program development, which will be updated with the final proposed budget in September.

#### **Expenditures**

Projected expenditures reflect changes in the salary and fringe package to accommodate the hiring of a permanent Executive Director and a Project Director for the Sustainable Communities Initiative. This category was reduced by over \$240,000 in Fiscal Year 2010-11 in order to close the funding gap in the amended budget before you today, and will need to increase by approximately \$112,000 to meet personnel requirements for the coming year. Pass-through expenditures for projects are reflected in the non-recurring professional services line item.
