### **LAUDERHILL**

#### **MEETING TACKLES U.S. 441 PROJECT**

The Florida Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting to discuss proposed improvements to U.S. 441 from Northwest Third Street to north of Northwest 29th Street in the Plantation, Lauderhill and Lauderdale Lakes areas.

The meeting will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday at the Broward County Public Library at the Lauderhill Mall, 4257 NW 12th St., Lauderhill.

The improvements include: Repaving U.S. 441, upgrading traffic signals, improved drainage, better lighting, improved sidewalks, and new landscaping and signs.

Construction is expected to begin in Winter 2005 and to be completed in about a year.

FDOT representatives will meet to discuss the project and answer questions.
