

RESOLUTION 04-03

A RESOLUTION BY THE STEERING COMMITTEE OF THE STATE ROAD 7/U.S. 441 COLLABORATIVE ENDORSING THE PROPOSED "TRANSIT ORIENTED CORRIDOR" AND "TRANSIT ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT" FUTURE LAND USE MAP CATEGORIES THAT FACILITATE AND PROMOTE THE UNIFIED REDEVELOPMENT EFFORTS OF EACH LOCAL GOVERNMENT ALONG THE STATE ROAD 7/U.S. 441 CORRIDOR.

Whereas, the Steering Committee of the Collaborative has expressed its desire to create an area-wide comprehensive and functional Master Plan to guide future redevelopment activities along the State Road 7/U.S. 441 Corridor in Broward County; and,

Whereas, the Steering Committee members wish to collaborate with other area local governments to address current land use, transportation, economic and aesthetic issues along the State Road 7/U.S. 441 Corridor and increase intergovernmental cooperation; and,

Whereas, the Broward County staff has worked along with members of the State Road 7 Land Use Sub-Committee to create Future Land Use Map categories that are supportive of redevelopment of the State Road 7 Strategic Master Plan; and,

Whereas, the County's proposed "Transit Oriented Corridor" and "Transit Oriented Development" categories would promote the redevelopment activities consistent with the recommendations of the State Road 7 Strategic Master Plan; and,

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Steering Committee of the State Road 7/U.S. 441 Collaborative that:

1. The Broward County Planning Council and the Broward County Commission consider transmitting the proposed "Transit Oriented Corridor" and "Transit Oriented Development" Future Land Use Map Categories as amendments to the Broward County Comprehensive Plan; and,
